

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT CIRCUS VARGAS

Where can I buy my tickets?

1. *You can charge by phone - 877/GOTFUN1 (877/468-3861) or on-line at circusvargas.org. We accept VISA, MasterCard and American Express..*
2. *You can buy your tickets at the Circus Box Office, right in front of the tent - open from 11:00 to 8:00 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday, and 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sundays.*

How do I order tickets by phone?

- *Your credit card will be charged at the time of purchase.*
- *You will receive a confirmation number.*
- *You need to bring the same credit card to the show for identification.*
- *If you are buying ringside seating, you will receive your seating assignment.*
- *Coupons will be honored – you will then need to bring the coupons to the show in order to receive your discount.*
- *Tickets cannot just be reserved over the phone – they need to be charged with a credit card.*
- *Phone ticket sales for a particular show stop an hour before each showtime.*

Where shall I pick up my will-call tickets?

Your tickets will be at the will-call table at the main entrance to the big top tent when you go to the show. You do not need to stand in line at the ticket office.

Will there be tickets right up to showtime?

Yes. There are always tickets available in every section right up until showtime.

Are the seats assigned seating?

Ringside section is assigned individual chairs. Arena and General Admission sections are first-come first-seated (in other words, if you purchase Arena, you can sit anywhere in the Arena chairs, or if you purchase General Admission, you can sit anywhere in the General Admission section).

What payment does Circus Vargas accept at the circus?

We accept cash, Visa, MasterCard and American Express. We do not take checks.

How long is the show?

Just under two hours.

How many rings are there?

It is a one-ring European-style tent. All the seats encircle the ring, so everyone gets a great view of the show.

How early should we get there?

Forty-five minutes before show time. However, there will be seats available right up to showtime and even after the show starts. Coming early gives you a chance to meet the performers in person and to get their autographs.

Do they sell refreshments at the show?

Yes – soft drinks and some food items – hot dogs, nachos, cotton candy, popcorn – all the traditional circus foods.

What about parking?

This depends on the location – usually there is free parking right next to the big top tent. At some fairgrounds, the fairgrounds charges for parking.

How many people does the tent hold?

About 1200 people per show.
